Welcome to Sechi Hair Academy

Sechi Hair Academy (TOID 41320) is a unique teaching academy, delivering nationally recognised qualifications in Hairdressing and Beauty Therapy, enabling students to gain hands-on experience in a simulated salon environment while furthering their education. Sechi Hair Academy equips students with the knowledge and competencies that will enable them to step out into the Hairdressing and Beauty Therapy industries.

Course Overview

This qualification reflects the role of individuals who work as beauty therapists to provide a range of beauty therapy treatments and services, including lash and brow treatments, nail services, make-up, massage and waxing. They communicate with clients to recommend treatments and services and sell retail skin care and cosmetic products.

Work is typically conducted in beauty salons and spas. No occupational licensing, certification or specific legislative requirements apply to this qualification at the time of publication.

Are there any pre-requisites or entry requirements?

There are no formal pre-requisites or entry requirements for **SHB40115 Certificate IV in Beauty Therapy**, however Sechi Hair Academy requires that students obtain approval from a parent or guardian if the student is under 18 years old.

Students are also required to attend an entry interview as part of their enrolment process to confirm that they understand the course delivery arrangements and expectations and that the course is suited to their career aspirations.

What units are included in this course?

Students in **SHB40115 Certificate IV in Beauty Therapy** are required to complete a total of nineteen (19) units to be awarded this qualification. This consists of thirteen (13) core units and six (6) set electives.

What is the duration of this course?

The **SHB40115 Certificate IV in Beauty Therapy** runs for approximately twelve (12) months, and is held four (4) days a week. Classes are held on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. All classes will commence at 9:15 AM and conclude at 3:45 PM, with a thirty (30) minute lunch break provided to all students at 12:15 PM.

All classes are compulsory as student attendance is vital to ensure students are taking part in classroom discussion and activities. If you are unable to attend class on the day, please notify your trainer at least thirty (30) minutes prior to the commencement of classes. Repeated absences may lead to deferment, and in severe cases, termination of your course.

Am I eligible for a Government Funded Training Place?

Generally, you are eligible for a government-subsidised training place if you are:

- an Australian citizen,
 - an Australian Permanent Resident (holder of permanent visa)
 - a New Zealand citizen,
- and are any of the following:
- under 20 years of age, or
 - 20 years and older and 'upskilling' by seeking to enrol in a course at a higher level than your existing qualification.

Additionally, holders of a valid Centrelink Concession Card will be eligible for further concessions.



How do I apply?

To apply for the **SHB40115 Certificate IV in Beauty Therapy**, you will first need to attend an appointment with Sechi Hair Academy's Enrolment Officer. If you are found to be suitable for training in this course, you will be provided with an information package that will include your Enrolment Application Form, which is to be completed prior to returning to Sechi Hair Academy.

You will then need to organise an enrolment appointment, during which time you will return your completed Enrolment Application Form. During this appointment, you will complete your Language, Literacy and Numeracy Assessment and all paperwork will be finalised, including organising your commencement date.
